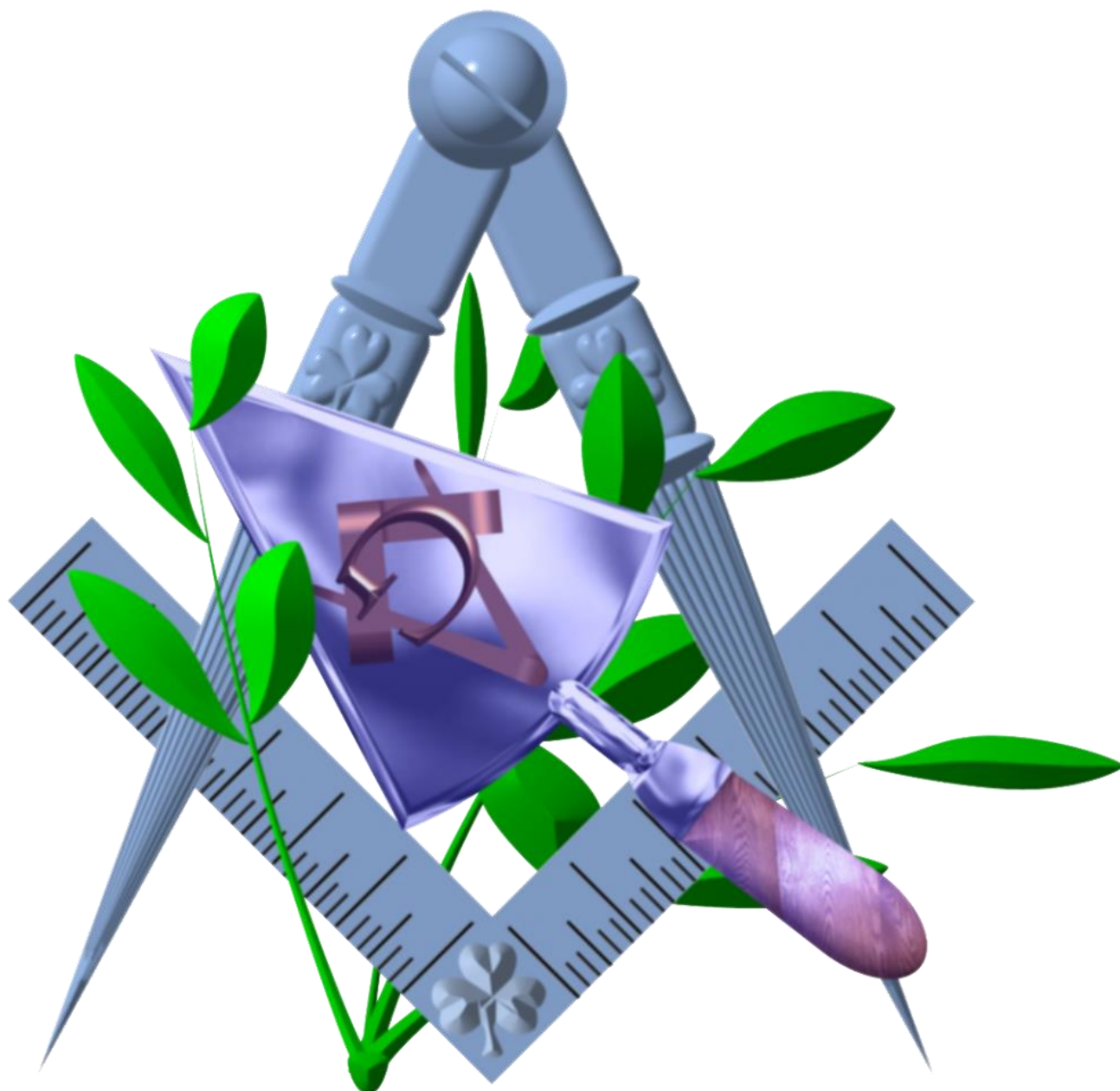

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Grootlosie van Suid-Afrika

Verklaring

Nademaal Vrymesselary sedert die jaar AD 1772 in Suider-Afrika onder die Groot Ooste van die Nederlande beoefen is en gedy het onder die heilsame bestuur van die Groot Ooste, het die Losies op Saterdag 18 Februarie 1961 in Kaapstad vergader en besluit om 'n Grootlosie in Suider-Afrika in die lewe te roep om Vrymesselary met besondere verwysing na die Aloue Opdragte ter bevorder. Die Grootlosie van Suider-Afrika wat in Kaapstad tot stand gekom het, se eerste vereiste vir toelating tot die Orde is dat elke lid ondubbelsinnig die volgende grondbeginsels onderskryf:

1. Die eerste voorwaarde vir toelating tot lidmaatskap van die Orde is 'n geloof in die Opperwese na wie die Vrymesselary verwys as die DOBVDH en Sy geopenbaarde wil. Dit is 'n essensiële voorwaarde en laat geen kompromis toe nie.
2. Die Bybel, waarna die Vrymesselaars verwys as die Boek Van Die Heilige Wet, lê altyd in Losies oop. Elke kandidaat is gehou om sy verpligtinge af te lê op dié Boek of Volume wat kragtens sy besondere geloof onskendbaarheid verleen aan 'n eed of belofte wat daarop afgelê is. Die Drie Groot Ligte van Vrymesselaary (naamlik DOBVDH, die Winkelhaak en Passer) moet altyd vertoon word tydens byeenkomste van die Grootlosie of sy Losies. Hiervan is DOBVDH (Die Boek Van Die Heilige Wet) die belangrikste.
3. Elkeen wat tot Vrymesselary toetree, word by toetrede streng verbied om hom met enige daad te vereenselwig wat vrede en goeie orde van die samelewing omver kan werp; hy moet die verskuldigde gehoorsaamheid betoon aan die wette van enige staat waarin hy woon of wat beskerming aan hom verleen, en hy mag nooit in gebreke bly in die nakoming van sy verskuldigde trou aan die staatshoof van sy land nie.
4. Terwyl die Suid-Afrikaanse Vrymesselary op die wyse gehoorsaamheid aan die staat en sy verantwoordelikhede as burger by elkeen van sy lede inskerp, gun dit die individu 'n eie siening oor sake van openbare belang. Maar nóg in die Losie, nóg te enige tyd in sy hoedanigheid as Vrymesselaar mag hy sy siening oor godsdienstige en of politieke kwessies bespreek of probeer bevorder.
5. Die Grootlosie stel 'n premie op die mens se individualiteit, sy sedelike aanspreeklikheid vir al sy handelinge, die fundamentele gelykheid van alle mense, die universele broederskap van die mens se plig om hom met toewyding te beywer vir die welsyn van die gemeenskap.

Declaration

Whereas Freemasonry has been practised in Southern Africa under the Grand East of the Netherlands since the year AD 1772 and having flourished exceedingly well under the benign rule of this Grand East, the Lodges have assembled at Cape Town on Saturday, February 18th, 1961, and determined on the formation of a Grand Lodge in Southern Africa for the furtherance of Freemasonry with special reference to the Ancient Charges. The Grand Lodge of Southern Africa first established at Cape Town demands that a prerequisite to admission to the Order is that every member shall unequivocally subscribe to the following basic principles:

1. The first condition of admission into, and membership of the Order is a belief in the Supreme Being referred to by Freemasons as TGAOTU and His revealed will. This is essential and admits no compromise
2. The Bible, referred to by Freemasons as The Volume of the Secret Law, is always open in the Lodges. Every candidate is required to take his Obligation on that Book or Volume which is held by his particular creed to impart sanctity to an oath or promise taken upon it. That Three Great Lights of Freemasonry (viz TVOSL, the Square and the Compasses) should always be exhibited when the Grand Lodge or its Lodges are at work, the chief of these being the TVOSL.
3. Everyone who enters Freemasonry is at the outset strictly forbidden to countenance any act which may have a tendency to subvert the peace and good order of society; he must pay due obedience to the Law of any State in which he resides or which may afford him protection, and must never be remiss in the allegiance due to the Head of State of his country.
4. While South African Freemasonry thus inculcates in each of its members the duties of loyalty and citizenship, it reserves to the individual the right to hold his own opinion with regard to public affairs. But neither in Lodge, nor any time in his capacity as a Freemason, is he permitted to discuss or to advance his view on religious or political questions
5. The Grand Lodge acknowledges the high value of human personality, man's responsibility for all his actions, the fundamental equality of all human beings, universal brotherhood of man and every man's duty to labour with devotion for the welfare of the community.

- 6 Die Grootlosie weerhou hom tuis, of in die buiteland, van kommentaar oor sake rakende buitelandse of binnelandse staatsbeleid; laat nie toe dat sy naam gekoppel word aan enige handeling, ongeag die skynbare humanitêre aard daarvan, wat inbreuk maak op sy onwrikbare beleid van onpartydigheid wat betref alle kwessies rakende betrekkinge tussen regerings of tussen politieke partye, of botsende teorieë oor staatsvorme.
- 7 Die Grootlosie weier volstrek om hom op welke wyse ookal te vereenselwig met liggame, wat hulle voordoen as Vrymesselaars, wat nie hierdie grondbeginsels onderskryf nie. Hy sal ook nie deelneem aan konferensies met sogenaamde internasionale organisasies wat lidmaatskap verleen aan liggame wat hulle nie streng by hierdie beginsels hou nie. Die Grootlosie kan nie deur so 'n organisasie verteenwoordig word nie.
- 8 Daar is niks geheimsinnig wat betref die grondbeginsels van Vrymesselary nie. Die Grootlosie sal altyd oorweging skenk aan die erkenning van en erkenning soek by daardie Grootlosies wat hierdie gevestigde en ongewysigde beginsels bely en bedryf het. In geen omstandighede sal dit aan 'n gesprek deelneem wat daarop gemik is om 'n nuwe of gewysigde interpretasie aan die reëls te gee nie. Die beginsels moet in die geheel volmondig bely en bedryf word deur die wat as Vrymesselaars erken wil word. Die Grootlosie sal verder geen betrekkinge aanknoop met 'n Grootlosie wat op 'n vriendskaplike voet verkeer met enige liggaam wat hom nie streng by hierdie basiese beginsels hou nie.
- 9 Die Grootlosie is 'n soewereine en onafhanklike liggaam en beskik oor soewereine mag oor Losies onder sy beheer, synde 'n verantwoordelike, onafhanklike, selfregerende organisasie met uitsluitlike gesag oor die Vak en Simboliese Grade binne sy administrasie. Dit erken nie die bestaan van enige hoër Masonieke gesag nie, hoe dit ookal betiteld word.
- 10 Die stigting van die Aloue, Vry en Aangenome Messelaars van Suider-Afrika as 'n soewereine en onafhanklike Grootlosie deur Losies met Oktrooie van die Groot Ooste van die Nederlande in die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, in Zimbabwe, en in Namibië, sal in geen opsig die regte en voorregte van enige Losie met 'n Magsbrief van die Verenigde Grootlosie van Engeland, die Grootlosie van Ierland en die Grootlosie van Skotland, wat nog altyd Masonieke gesag op gelyke voet in die genoemde oop gebiede gedeel het, aantas nie, en in hulle diskresie Oktrooie toegestaan het aan nuwe Losies.
- Dit is die wens van die Grootlosie van Suid-Afrika dat hierdie harmonieuse gesindheid en gelykheid wat betref gesag in die toekoms soos in die verlede sal voortbestaan en verklaar hierby uitdruklik:
6. The Grand Lodge refuses to express any opinion on questions of foreign or domestic state policy either at home or abroad, and it will not allow its

- name to be associated with any action, however humanitarian it may appear to be, which infringes its unalterable policy of standing aloof from every question affecting the relations between governments or between political parties or questions as to rival theories of government.
- 7 The Grand Lodge refuses absolutely to have any relations with Bodies, styling themselves as Freemasons, which do not adhere to these basic principles. Nor will it participate in Conference with so-called International Associations which fail to conform strictly to these principles. The Grand Lodge cannot be represented by any such Association.
- 8 There is no secret with regard to any of the basic principles of Freemasonry. The Grand Lodge will always consider the recognition by those Grand Lodges which profess and practise and can show that they have consistently professed and practised these established and unaltered principles, but in no circumstances will it enter into discussion with a view to any new or varied interpretation of them. They must be accepted and practised wholeheartedly and in their entirety by those who desire to be recognised as Freemasons. Furthermore, the Grand Lodge will not enter into relation with a Grand Lodge, which is in amity with any body, which does not adhere strictly to these basic principles.
- 9 The Grand Lodge is sovereign and independent body and shall have sovereign jurisdiction over the Lodges under its control, being a responsible, independent, self governing organisation with sole authority over the Craft or Symbolic Degrees within its administration. It does not recognise or admit the existence of any superior Masonic authority however styled.
- 10 The establishment of the Grand Lodge of Ancient and Accepted Masons of Southern Africa as a sovereign and independent Grand Lodge by Lodges holding Charters from the Grand East of the Netherlands in the Republic of South Africa, in Zimbabwe and Namibia, shall in no way affect the rights and privileges enjoyed by any Lodges holding Warrant from the United Grand Lodge of England, the Grand Lodge of Ireland and the Grand Lodge of Scotland, which have always shared Masonic jurisdiction in the said territories; and have granted Charters for new Lodges at their discretion..

The Grand Lodge of South Africa desires that this harmonious relationship and equality of jurisdiction should continue in the future as in the past, and thereby expressly declares:

- (a) Dat al die Losies en die Koninklike Gewelfkapittels van Engelse, Ierse en Skotse oorsprong steeds erken sal word op 'n grondslag van absolute gelykheid.
- (b) Dat die Verenigde Grootlosie van Engeland, die Grootlosie van Ierland en die Grootlosie van Skotland steeds die bevoegdheid sal hê om in hulle diskresie nuwe Oktrooie uit te reik vir nuwe Losies (en Koninklike Gewelfkapittels) tot tyd en wyl dit gerade of nodig geag word om 'n Verenigde Grootlosie van Suider-Afrika deur die vier Konstitusies kragtens 'n onderlinge ooreenkoms te stig.
- (c) Dat die bestaan van die Grootlosie van Suider-Afrika as 'n onafhanklike Grootlosie nie die stigting van tyd tot tyd in oop gebiede deur die Verenigde Grootlosie van Engeland, Grootlosie van Ierland en die Grootlosie van Skotland en hul onderskeie Distriks- en Provinsiale Grootlosies en Dogterlosies van 'n ander of ander Grootlosies, met uitsluitlike gesag in oop gebiede oor die Vak en Simboliese Grade onder hulle administratiewe beheer, uitsluit nie.
- (d) Dat aangesien Zimbabwe en Zambië buite die Republiek van Suid-Afrika geleë is, onderneem hierdie Grootlosie om nie Oktrooie vir nuwe Losies in hierdie gebiede uit te reik nie en dat sy jurisidiksie streng beperk word tot die sewe bestaande Losies wat tans in Zimbabwe en Zambië werksaam is.
- 11 Dat die lidmaatskap van die Grootlosie en die individuele Losies uitsluitlik uit mans sal bestaan; en dat elke Grootlosie nie Masonieke gemeenskap van enige aard sal hê met gemengde Losies of liggame wat vroue toelaat nie.
- 12 Dat die beginsels van die Aloue Landmerke, sedes en gebruike van die Vak stiptelik nagekom sal word. Met die toestemming van die Grootlosies van Engeland, Ierland en Skotland, is die naam van die Grootlosie van Suider-Afrika op 8 Junie 1979, na samesprekings met die Grootlosie van Engeland verander na die Grootlosie van Suid-Afrika en bekragtig op 8 Oktober 1979. Waar die naam Suider-Afrika voorkom, moet dit geles word as Suid-Afrika.
- (a) That all the Lodges, and Royal Arch Chapters, of English, Irish, or Scottish origin, shall continue to be recognised on a basis of absolute equality.
- (b) The United Grand Lodge of England, the Grand Lodge of Ireland and the Grand Lodge of Scotland, shall continue to have the right to grant new Charters for new Lodges (and Royal Arch Chapters) at their discretion, until such time in the future when it might be expedient or necessary to form a United Grand Lodge of Southern Africa by the four Constitutions acting by mutual agreement.
- (c) That the existence of the Grand Lodge of Southern Africa as a sovereign and independent Grand Lodge shall not preclude the establishment in the open territories from time to time by the United Grand Lodge of England, the Grand Lodge of Ireland and the Grand Lodge of Scotland, and their respective District and Provincial Grand Lodges and daughter Lodges of another or other Grand Lodges with sole and sovereign Masonic jurisdiction in the open territories over the Craft and Symbolic Degrees within their administration
- (d) That as Zimbabwe and Zambia are States outside the Republic of South Africa, this Grand Lodge undertakes not to grant any Charters for new Lodges in those territories and its jurisdiction is strictly confined to the seven Lodges at present existing and working in Zimbabwe and Zambia.
- 11 That the membership of the Grand Lodge and individual Lodges shall be composed exclusively of men; and that each Grand Lodge shall have no Masonic intercourse of any kind with mixed Lodges or bodies which admit women to membership.
- 12 That the principles of the Ancient Landmarks, customs, and usages of the Craft shall be strictly observed. With the consent of the Grand Lodges of England, Ireland and Scotland, the name of the Grand Lodge of Southern Africa was changed to the Grand Lodge of South Africa following discussions with the Grand Lodge of England on 8 June 1979 and confirmed on 8 October 1979. Consequently, wherever the name Southern Africa appears, it must read as South Africa.

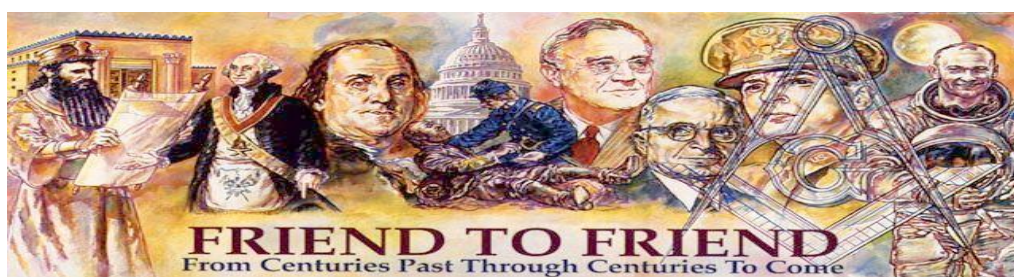

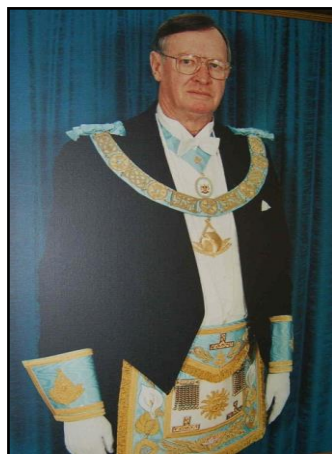

ANNUAL REPORT OF THE PROVINCIAL GRAND MASTER - SOUTHERN DIVISION 2013

Most Worshipful, Right Worshipful, Very Worshipful, Worshipful Brethren and Brethren all, - I extend to you all a very hearty, fraternal and sincere welcome to this Province's Annual General Meeting. We have just celebrated the milestone of this Provincial Grand Lodge's 150th anniversary, I would particularly like to thank the Grand Master and the officers of Grand Lodge for conducting the re-dedication ceremony we have just witnessed prior to this meeting. I wish to welcome all the distinguished visiting brethren, it is indeed a great privilege to have you present here today and I thank you all for attending this meeting, which I trust you will find interesting and informative.

My report today will be presented in English for the benefit of our international guests and it is in this regard that I ask for forgiveness from our Afrikaans Brethren.

I wish to take this opportunity to thank RW Bro. John Smith my immediate Past Provincial Grand Master and the Assistant Grand Master responsible for this division for all his support, guidance and advice which has been invaluable in my first term of office as well as RW Bro Geoff Edwards the Deputy Grand Master for all his advice and behind the scenes assistance he provides for this Division which is much appreciated. I would also like to thank my Deputy, Wor Bro Ronnie Smith, most sincerely for his continued support, assistance and advice and my Assistant Provincial Grand Masters, the Wor Brethren Len Kingsley, John Miller and Louis Van De Linde for their continued invaluable contribution to the management of this Provincial Grand Lodge and to the promotion of Freemasonry in this Province. Wor Bro John Miller regrettably will, after five years of loyal service to PGL, be relinquishing the Office of Assistant Provincial Grand Master which he has held for three years. I would like to thank him for his support and for the contribution he has made to the efficient functioning of Provincial Grand Lodge.

I also wish to thank RW Alf Rhodie who after 14 years of service as Provincial Grand Secretary decided to stand down in March this year so that he could enjoy his retirement. Rt Wor Bro Rhodie a Past Provincial Grand Master of this Division has been in active service in the Provincial Grand Lodge structure for the past 26 years. I am pleased to report that notwithstanding his retirement as PG Secretary, he has accepted my invitation to him to serve again on the Provincial Grand Management Committee and I look forward to his valued contribution.

Lastly, but by no means the least, I wish to thank the Provincial Grand Lodge Officers, both present and past, for your continued support, commitment and dedication.

It gives me much pleasure to announce the appointment of Wor Bro Andre Engelbrecht, the Provincial Grand Junior Warden, as an Assistant Provincial Grand Master and it will be my privilege to obligate and invest him as such later today.

My appointment of the active Provincial Grand Lodge Officers for 2013 / 2014 was again done after consultation with the Provincial Grand Executive Committee and with the approval of the Provincial Grand Management Committee and they will also be obligated and invested today. To you Brethren, I thank you for accepting these appointments and I trust that we will receive your full support of all the activities of this Provincial Grand Lodge during the next year. Without your active participation, this Provincial Grand Lodge cannot function.

On the administrative side, my sincere thanks are extended to the acting Provincial Grand Secretary, Wor Bro Mervyn Metcalfe and to his assistant, Mrs. June Cox for ensuring that this very important part of the management of this Province is maintained in good order. In his short time as acting PGL Secretary Wor Bro Metcalf has made great strides in streamlining and computerizing the administrative processes of the Provincial Grand Lodge Office and I look forward to further developments in this regard. His commitment behind the scenes is also not only invaluable but is also very much appreciated. It will be my privilege to obligate and invest him as Provincial Grand Secretary later today.

We continue to enjoy a very good and close relationship with the management and members of our Sister Divisions. I particularly wish to thank the Provincial Grand Masters of the Northern, Eastern, Central and Eastern Cape Divisions as well as the Brethren accompanying them here today for their attendance. You have all traveled long distances to be here today, and for this I am eternally grateful. I would also like to take this opportunity to thank you, your officers, brethren and your good ladies for the exceptional hospitality which you always afford us when we visit you in your respective Divisions.

We also continue to enjoy a close and fraternal relationship with our Sister Constitutions. The quarterly informal meetings held with the Provincial and District Grand Masters and Deputies of the English, Irish and Scottish Constitutions to

discuss Masonic matters of mutual interest are most enjoyable and productive and long may this co-operative initiative continue. We continue to enjoy the company of the representatives of our Sister Constitutions at most of our installation ceremonies and we are only too happy to reciprocate this honor when invited to do so.

The “Potjiekos” competition; the annual Church service and the operation of the Freemason’s Square at the annual Carnival of the Cape Town Community Chest continue to be inter – constitutional events. As one of the patrons of the inter – constitutional Masonic Education Fund, I am pleased to report that the Fund was able to award 17 bursaries in respect of 9 School Scholars and 8 University Students. It is my pleasure to report that I have appointed Wor Bro Jock Wood to assist Wor Bro Heinz Smekal as our representative on the Education Fund Committee. Wor Bro Wood replaces Wor Bro Raymond Supra who served for many years as our representative for which we sincerely thank him. I wish to extend my sincere thanks to the Management and to the Brethren of our Sister Constitutions for their continued friendship and support of the Grand Lodge of South Africa in this Province.

The City came together on 11 November 2012 to share in a Day of Remembrance for those who fell in armed conflict so that we can enjoy the freedom and liberties of today. The Southern Division and our Sister Constitutions were invited to attend the Remembrance Day Celebrations, which were hosted by the City of Cape Town and the Executive Deputy Mayor, Alderman Ian Nielson. The day brought together ex-servicemen and the participation of the South African Army, Air Force, Navy, Military Health Services, Moths, Freemasons, etc. The English, Irish, Scottish and South African Constitutions, which were all personally represented by their District and Provincial Grand Masters, jointly laid a wreath on behalf of the Freemasons of the Western Cape. Several brethren also attended the celebration wearing Lodge Regalia. This was a great opportunity to show our respects and at the same time to showcase Freemasonry in the Western Cape. All who attended were invited to a cocktail party after the event which was hosted by the City.

Although we have experienced a growth in our membership since our meeting last year, this has unfortunately been affected by several of our Brethren passing to the Eternal East, emigrating and relocating to other parts of the country. We are however quite aware of the Grand Master’s expressed desire of doubling our membership by 2020 and with this in mind we as a Division have embarked in a Vision 2020 Strategy.

Late in 2011, the Grand Master shared his vision for 2020. His vision was clear, we needed to

double our membership by 2020, the way we would do this was simple, we needed to Recruit new members, Retain the ones we have and get those left out in the cold to Rejoin the order (the 3R’s as it has become known).

In 2012, the PGL Southern Division embarked on a journey to unpack and understand what this would mean for our Division. The Grand Master’s vision was a call to action and we needed to play our role to enable, support and contribute towards its success.

During our first workshop, Exco members worked together to unpack and understand the challenges that we face. Questions were asked on why we are struggling to attract good quality men, why were people joining but leave soon after, and what would be required to have those we have lost to return. We debated and discussed what we as a division can offer, what we wanted to be known for and how will we know if we achieved success. This set the scene for discussing the key areas we believe we need to focus on to enable the 3R’s and deliver towards the Grand Master’s vision.

Earlier this year we shared this vision, ambition and areas of focus with a select group of Brethren from our Division. During this session we validated the vision and ambition. We started to unpack and refine each of the identified focus areas and with the assistance of the Brethren present we consolidated the focus areas from five to three. Under each of these focus areas a number of programs have been identified. And although some coordination will be required by PGL, the success of this strategy lies with each one of us in the division. Its success depends on each lodge, each master, warden, officer and member to make it work. We believe that if we are successful, we will be able to attract and recruit good quality men, we will be able to actively keep them engaged and retain them. Members that have left will have a reason to come back with very little convincing required.

Over the next few months, we plan to schedule a session with every lodge. During these sessions we will share the details of the strategy, gain further input and extend an open invitation to join us on this exciting journey. A journey to reclaim our space and once again become the great organization we are destined to be.

Most of the Lodges are very active and Lodge Westerford was awarded the trophy for the best Lodge of the Year, as well as the trophy for the best Ritual work. Lodge De Goede Hoop was awarded the trophy for the most Chartable Lodge of the year and Lodge Johan van Riebeeck was awarded the trophy for the Lodge showing the most progress. These floating trophies were presented to the Lodges at the annual meeting for the Presiding Masters, Wardens, Secretaries and Treasurers and

are proudly displayed by the Lodges at their ceremonial workings. It is most pleasing to witness the fraternal yet fierce competition which exists between the Lodges as they compete to win these prestigious annual awards.

Both Lodge Mutual and Lodge Perseverance are struggling to attract and keep new members due to the fact that they are both short in numbers and cannot provide meaningful workings and a proper lodge environment that will stimulate and retain new initiates.

In view of the above I recently granted dispensation for these two lodges to combine their Ceremonial Workings on an alternate month basis. These lodges will however keep their identities and hold independent Board of Management meetings. I am pleased to report that this initiative is working well with meaningful workings of a high standard, having been completed. I call upon all brethren and lodges to support Lodges Perseverance and Mutual in their labours.

Lodges St Jan, Oranje and Zur Eintracht are also struggling with members and sustainability. With the assistance of my Executive and Management committees, I will be in discussion with these lodges to design a strategy to assist them in their sustained growth. In the interim, I call upon all brethren to also assist these lodges wherever possible as it will be a very sad day to see any one of these distinguished lodges hand in their Charter.

I wish to thank Wor Bro Cedric Moroukian for ensuring that the events and the activities of the Province, the Lodges, the Royal Arch Chapters and the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite are distributed per email every week. I would also like to thank RW Bro Geoff Edwards for updating and maintaining our website. I call on all brethren to regularly visit our Website which is singularly the most important source for the dissemination of information and educational material in this Province.

The Tranquillity Project has been resurrected under the leadership of the Deputy Provincial Grand Master, Wor Bro Ronnie Smith. It is represented by a group of Brethren proficient in ritual work. The main aim of the Tranquillity Project is to conduct the GLSA Open Working "What is Freemasonry" as well as to perform Demonstration Workings in all Degrees. The Tranquillity Project also has a database of Brethren proficient in specific charges. These brethren have made themselves available to assist lodges struggling to find a Lodge Member to do a specific charge. The Tranquillity Team recently conducted a Demonstration Working of the Apprentice degree at the Regular combined Meeting of Lodges Perseverance and Mutual in July and intends holding an open evening later this year where the ritual, "What is Freemasonry" will be performed. I

would like to express my sincere thanks to the Tranquillity Team for their dedication and commitment in ensuring that by their example, every Candidate for a degree working receives and enjoys a quality and a meaningful experience.

A successful annual meeting for Masters, Wardens and Secretaries was held in March this year. This meeting was well supported and various topics of general importance were discussed and implemented. It was suggested at this meeting that lodges open their management meetings with a Prayer, I am pleased to report that most Lodges have implemented this initiative and included it on their meeting agendas

The Southern Division, again this year, hosted the Freemasons Stall at the annual Community Chest Carnival in Wynberg. We were once again assisted by Brethren of the English, Irish and Scottish constitutions. Despite the poor attendance this year, the Freemasons Stall managed to generate a record profit of R88000.00 which was handed to the Community Chest for their distribution to the charities they support. The Freemasons Stall has become one of the major contributors at the Maynardville Carnival and this something that we as Freemasons in the Western Cape can be truly proud of. The assistance received from Lodges and Brethren this year was however disappointingly poor and we sincerely hope and rely on Presiding Masters of Lodges to encourage their Brethren to come forward and volunteer their services next year. The Freemasons Stall was very fortunate to have received assistance from students of the University of the Western Cape who helped to man the stall as part of their Community Service commitment. We have already received a commitment from the University that they will support us again next year. Without the efforts of the Organizing Committee, their assistants and volunteers, this event would not be possible. It is in this regard, that I sincerely thank all those involved in the operation of our stall this year, the list of their names is just too long to mention in this report. Be however assured of our deep appreciation for all your efforts which does not go unnoticed.

The Inter Constitutional Potjiekos Competition which was hosted by the English constitution was well supported by the South African Constitution Lodges in the Southern Division. This year 14 Pots were entered, the majority coming from the SAC. The number of entries this year was down from last year but this did not detract from the comradeship between the Constitutions and Lodges, and a fun filled family day was had by all. This year's beneficiary was Lady Michaelis Clinic at Timour Hall. The net profit from sum raised will go towards their Soil for Life Program.

Due to the spiralling costs of maintaining the Lodge Bellville Masonic complex in Bellville, Lodge Bellville decided to accept an offer of purchase for their building. The sale was concluded in November 2012 and all Bellville tenant lodges have been accommodated at the PGL Complex in Cape Town. To assist PGL with the costs associated with accommodating the tenant lodges, Lodge Bellville kindly donated a sum of R5000.00 to the PGL Building Development Fund and a further sum of R50 000 to PGL of which a sizeable portion was allocated to the benevolent fund.

Last year's Spring Ball was again a resounding success and the Committee donated a record amount of R125 000,00 from its proceeds to our Masonic Homes project. Our 39th annual Spring Ball this evening which has for the first time incorporated a Masked Ball theme, promises to be even more spectacular than in the past and I wish to thank the convener, RW Bro John Smith and his Committee most sincerely for their hard work and dedication in this regard. As has become customary, RW Bro Edwards has again compiled the Spring Ball magazine which will in all probability prove to be another bumper edition. I wish to take this opportunity to thank him most sincerely for his continued dedication and commitment in this regard and I trust that he will continue to do so for many more years to come.

Our Masonic Homes, being Desmain Lodge Ted's House, Burchell House and Andy's House as well as our Home for Quadriplegics continue to operate happily and efficiently and I again thank the members of the House Committees and all the other Brethren and their families who sacrifice much of their time and energy to ensure that this remains so. The Chairman of the Board of Directors of Denid Investments, RW Bro Edwards, will deliver a report on our Masonic Homes under a separate item on this Agenda.

It is pleasing to report that we are not only continuing to strive to provide comfortable and affordable accommodation for the elderly and the infirm but that the members of our Lodges regularly visit our Masonic Homes and take the residents out on excursions and host lunch and supper events for

them. We cannot however rest on our laurels as the need for a Children's Home, Frail Care facility and more of these Residential Homes in this Province is very real. Brethren, your continued, generous and unselfish financial support of our fund raising activities in general and particularly of our Spring Ball tonight, which is our main fund raising event for our Masonic Homes Project, will greatly assist us to realize this dream.

The Masonic Quad Home in Durbanville, held its Annual Golf Day on 9 November 2012. They were assisted by the Convener, VW Bro Malcolm Lotter and his team of brethren from the division. This event was a resounding success and the Committee members need to be commended and thanked for their sterling efforts which paid off handsomely. The amount raised was in excess of R37 000 which far exceeds the best efforts of the past. All the money raised is for the internal running of the Masonic Quad Home. Although the Golf Day is not an official PGL event, we can rightly feel duty-bound to support the event as this well-equipped and exquisite Home forms a proud part of the Masonic Homes Project of the Southern Division.

In December last year, we hosted our annual dinner for the Provincial Grand Lodge Officers and their partners, to which we also invited the widows of our departed brethren. As usual, we also hosted a Xmas Lunch for the residents of our Masonic homes which was thoroughly enjoyed.

Finally, I wish to thank the GAOTU for giving me the strength and the ability to fulfill my duties as the Provincial Grand Master. I also wish to thank my partner and my family for their love, patience and support and I pray that the GAOTU will bless us in all our Masonic activities and will spare us so that we may meet here again next year. To all our Visitors, I trust that you will enjoy your brief stay with us and that you will all travel safely back to your homes and to your loved ones.

The Annual Christmas hamper fund is under strain for funding the demands being placed on them, but to date we aim to continue with the project. I am particularly proud of in particular Lodge's First United, Meerensee and Dromedaris who each contributed in excess of R 10 000.00 towards this fund.

The total contribution from all our Lodges exceeded R 35 000.00 which must be largest single donation made by our Division towards a common and deserving charity cause.

Our Division has been active in attending the installations of Sister Constitution lodges and during the last year the Officers of Provincial Grand Lodge made a total of 24 official visits to the English Constitution, 9 to the Irish Constitution, and 11 to the Scottish Constitution.

All the Constitutions participated in the November 2012 Remembrance Day (also known as Poppy Day or Armistice Day) at which we as the four Constitutions attended in full Masonic Regalia and together laid a wreath at the Cenotaph. A number of Brethren were afforded the opportunity of laying their personal wreaths.

Sister Divisions

Southern Division

To Worshipful Brother Avron Jacobson, who is now spearheading the Southern Division, thank you for your attendance here today. One of the ideals of the establishment of Lodge Isandlwana was that our Sister Divisions would find cause to also raise their own Military lodges in their Divisions, given the rich military and Masonic history of our country.

Central Division

To Wor Bro Alf Bronner, thank you for making us so welcome at your annual meetings in Bloemfontein. We look forward to your Free State Highland Gathering Team at our next Gathering on 24th August this year. You took most of the trophies last year, so the challenge is on. You must be warned; all the Judges are Freemasons from Kwazulu Natal. Brothers Doug Thomson, Kirton, Roberts, Coertze, Len Heine who play a prominent part, are known to be impartial to the Scottish nectar.

Northern Division

Johan, we hope to again this year invade your Province with a large contingent of PGL Officers from Kwazulu Natal.

Eastern Cape Division

To Wor Bro Johan in the Eastern Cape, I again apologies for not having attended your annual meeting due to my travels to the Grand Lodge of India but will make amends this year and look forward to your meeting.

Master's, Wardens and Secretaries Meeting

The Annual Masters, Wardens, Secretaries and Treasurers Meeting was held on Saturday 11th May at Hunt Road.

The PGL Secretary expressed his pet hates and explained in detail the necessity of the various forms to ensure the efficient running of their lodges and gave his understanding to assist the various changes of Lodge Secretaries and to develop a common standard based on the Constitution and requirements of the Provincial Grand Secretaries office.

Each Lodge Secretary was given a CD containing all the relevant documents required by the PG Secretary to perform their tasks, together with template documents on letters to applicants, Initiates, Fellow crafts and Master Masons. Letters to wives and partners informing them what Freemasonry is about and how they can contact the Office of The Provincial Grand Lodge were included with the intention that Lodge Secretaries be given supporting information to

“professionalize” their function within their Lodges.

I am pleased to see that these are already in constant use.

Lodge Activities and Vision 2020

All the Lodges have conducted regular meetings and in particular, cross – support of workings and participation by choice is still a regular occurrence amongst Lodges.

These activities are well covered in our Quarterly Reports and I urge all our Lodge Officers and members to actively work towards the objectives of Vision 2020 to grow your members first and developing effective ways to positively impact the performance of your Lodges with the intention of generating enthusiastic interest of members alongside the core of the ritual understanding and thereby make Freemasonry meaningful and fun.

To the members of Lodge Isandlwana, I again thank you for the trust placed in the petitioning members of the Lodge.

I believe that this lodge will attract and inspire a positive rewarding Masonic experience that will contribute to greater personal growth and enjoyment for the members and their families.

The Lodges have all gained members and in particular are attracting younger enthusiastic members who are all turning out to be committed and interested. This I believe is due to the enthusiasm for Freemasonry in our Lodges. Again, these statistics are positive and with the formation of Lodge Isandlwana coming into being, we have increased our Provincial membership significantly.

Provincial Grand Secretary.

Once again, our Provincial Office has been run like clockwork, by Worshipful Brother Eric Cahill and his dear wife Augusta. The dedication, effort and efficient performance make it all seem so easy and just saying thank you seems so inadequate. We appreciate their dedication greatly.

Here I have to pay tribute to Wor Bro Basil do Kock who started an initiative to raise in excess of R15 500 as contribution towards our Provincial Grand Secretaries new car when his was so tragically stolen. To all the individuals and Lodges who made such a magnanimous gesture come true, you have really shown the spirit of what Freemasonry is all about.

Masonic Benevolence

The generous donations from our Lodges and all Brethren have made it possible for us to honour all our benevolence commitments in the form of donations to the Malvern Children's Home, the Inter-Constitutional Masonic Services Hamper Fund and the Wesley Francis Memorial Education Fund. The Lodges in the Division have also been active in their own charity projects giving donations to local charities of their choice.

Masonic Education

All our apprentices are presented with a copy of "Basic Introduction to Freemasonry" and the Grand Lodge of South Africa, which is followed up with the relative sections for Fellow Craft and Master Masons, as they progress. RT Worshipful Brother George Schuitemaker plays a most valuable role in the preparation of these papers prior to them being presented and for this we thank him most sincerely.

Within the province, we are compiling a Masonic Education Mentorship Program which will devote their efforts to enhancing Master Masons in their progress.

A proposal for a Virtual masonic Library which we had discussed a number of years ago has again been revived. To give this concept substance, our PGL Manco have elected to call this new library (after

much persuasion), the @George Schuitemaker Masonic Library@. As this is not a lodges name, we did not have to kill him to use his name. I thank Rt Wor Schuitemaker for finally accepting with grace that we wish to also honour the ideal of Masonic Education. The working concept of how the Virtual Library will operate will be released to all the Lodges for implementation.

Conclusion

The year under review has passed so quickly and has been a most active and satisfying one, thanks to the wonderful support I have received from my Provincial Grand Lodge team and the Masters and Brethren of all the Lodges.

It has been most encouraging that the Division has been through a positive year with all our Lodges functioning well, thanks to the commitment of all the Presiding Masters and Brethren as well as the Provincial Grand Lodge team.

Lastly, to my dear wife Barbara, for her love, unstinting support and encouragement, without which all of my Masonic activities would not be possible.
